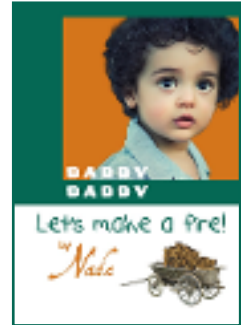


Daddy, Daddy Let's Make a Fire
